WHEREAS, these developers would like the Parish Commission to consider Caddo Parish providing support;

WHEREAS, the Caddo Parish Commission wishes to engage in non-binding discussions with developers on this project;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Caddo Parish Commission in due, regular and legal session convened, authorizes the Parish Administrator and Commission to enter into non-binding discussion about the development. These discussions shall not be construed as the Parish of Caddo committing any endorsement or funding of the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if any provision or item of this resolution or the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items or applications which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items or applications, and to this end, the provisions of this resolution are hereby declared severable.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
